TO BE CONSIDERED, YOUR RESIDENT MUST FULFILL THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

1. Resident resides in an Aging Services member organization.
2. Resident is invited to attend our 2012 Annual Summer Conference, Tuesday June 5th, The Davenport Hotel, Spokane for acceptance.
3. Member organization must provide appropriate staff to accompany Senior Star to our 2012 Annual Summer Conference if resident is able to travel.
4. The nomination information may be more than one page, and include a photograph of the resident. The nomination should include what the resident has accomplished in your community to distinguish him/her as your Senior Star. **Tell us about the resident's special contributions to your community. Help us "To tell their story....!"**
5. Contact must be able to furnish evidence to corroborate nomination. The more verification you have (photos, third party statements, certificates, newspaper articles, etc.) the more credibility is lent to the nomination.
6. Resident must be willing to be interviewed and to participate in the interview process and willing to be videotaped.
7. Each organization can nominate at least two Senior Star nominees annually.
8. Prior year submissions may be re-submitted to nominating committee at your request! Committee will accept additional information if received.



The nominations will be reviewed by a task force from the Professional Development Committee and Aging Services CEO. Two finalists will be selected. Once the selection is final and resident notified, a team of videographers will be scheduled at each organization for the taping of interviews.

The winners will be honored during our **General Session: Tuesday, June 5th, between 8:30 – 10:00 a.m. at The Davenport Hotel in Spokane!** The videotapes of the winners will be shown, which will culminate with the presentation of the Senior Star Award winners. The winners will receive a night's lodging for themselves and either a family member or organization personnel the evening before the award presentation. The winners will also be presented with a plaque, and a copy of the award winning videotape, plus a unique gift. Aging Services will request gift ideas for the winning residents.
